| Form: | For all students 13 and over, you must enter using the online registration form at www.artandwriting.org Students will need email accounts in order to register online. For all students 12 and under, paper forms have been mailed to the school or can be picked up at Kendall. Signatures are required from the student, teacher, and parent/guardian. Please firmly attach one copy of the entry form to the back of the piece. Please give a second copy of the entry form to us when you deliver the work. Both forms must be signed. |
| Size limitations: | 2-D artwork must be 36" x 48" or smaller 3-D artwork must be 18" x 18" x 36" or smaller and no more than 30 lb |
| Categories: | Please see the Scholastic Art Awards Submission Guidelines 2008 – enclosed in this packet for full category descriptions. |
| Labels: | Please clearly label each piece of artwork with the students name, school, city and state. This is in addition to the entry form! |
| Preparation: | All 2-D work must be mounted on a rigid board. Use only black or white matting if matting is necessary. No frames, glass, Plexiglas, or wood strips – canvas submissions are accepted on wooden supports. Protective sheets such as glassine or acetate are highly recommended for drawings. |

- Portfolios:** Both Art and Photography Portfolios are submitted on CD-Rom only. Please see the portfolio guidelines for detailed information on preparing a portfolio. Please make sure to include the Artist's Statement, Letter of Recommendation, the Submission Forms and the CD-Rom of images.
- Multiple Entries:** Multiple entries by the same student are allowed. Students may submit pieces in both the Portfolio and Individual Entry categories.
- Delivery of Work:** Work from each school must arrive as a group and must be delivered by the teacher. Please make sure to box all of your work together and package all work carefully. Please clearly label your boxes with the school name and teacher name.
- Jurying:** A panel of local and regional artists and arts professionals will be assembled to jury the work.
- Notification:** Representatives of Kendall will call or email each teacher regarding the jury results on Friday, December 14th. Please be aware that we have **many** phone calls to make and we will let you know the results as soon as we possibly can.
