

2012-2013 Kendall Merit Scholarship For Current (Art History) Kendall Students



TO BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR A KENDALL SCHOLARSHIP OF MERIT, YOU MUST:

1. Be currently enrolled at least half-time (6 credits) at Kendall College of Art and Design of FSU
2. Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.3 (Undergrad), 3.5 (Graduate) or above
3. Submit the completed Current Kendall Student Scholarship of Merit Application Form
4. Art History scholarship applicants will be required to participate in a 25 point "Period and/or Style" Identification Quiz session led by the Art History Program. Each student will also be required to complete a hand-written analysis of a slide image selected by the Art History Program. The date of the Quiz session will be announced after the scholarship application deadline of February 15, 2012.
5. Submit a CD-ROM including the following:
 - Digital copy of your typewritten essay (described below). The digital copy must be saved as a PDF.
6. Submit a printed, hard-copy (in addition to the digital copy) of your essay (approximately 2-3 pages in length, double spaced, 11 or 12 sized font in Times New Roman) in which you respond to the following questions:
 - What have been significant events in your artistic/intellectual development?
 - What are your principle interests when not making or researching about art?
 - What kind of materials (books, magazines, exhibitions, films, etc.) do you read or view about art or culture? How does it affect your art/design work or art historical scholarship? If not, what does affect your art/design work or art historical scholarship?
 - What are your strengths and importantly, your limitations as an artist/designer, of your work and your academic research and writing skills?
 - Name an artist/designer, past or present, who has inspired you to become an artist/designer or art historian? What about their work did you find most intriguing?

All application materials must be submitted in a 9" x 12" envelope with the applicant's name and student number clearly printed on the outside.

Note: Make sure you have copies of your application materials—the materials you submit become the property of Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University and will not be returned to you.

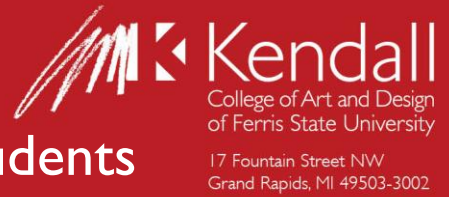
