Regular Admission

Kendall College of Art and Design welcomes students who are committed to developing their artistic talent. Students seeking regular admission to a degree program must have a high school diploma (or equivalent). Students should have earned a minimum high school G.P.A. of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or have achieved an ACT composite score of 17 or a SAT combined score of 820.

Provisional Admission

Students who do not meet the preceding requirements may be accepted on a provisional basis, based on past academic performance or scores on the ACT or SAT examination. Special course placement will be considered, and the student will be required to meet with the College Counselor and the student's academic advisor on a regular basis.
